The majority of all burglaries occur at residences. Thieves see businesses as better equipped with security measures such as guards, cameras & more sophisticated alarms. However, homes with no alarm systems are easy targets. The new trend in home burglaries is forced entry during the day. A criminal has many ways to determine who is at home and who is not. He may knock on the door or even call the house. If there is no answer, he knows he has more time to take what he wants. Many criminals work in teams and may show up in moving vans or service vehicles that won't look as suspicious in the neighborhood. With the increase of people away from home during the day and neighbors who don't know each other, home burglaries climb each year.

Even homes with alarm systems are only protected if the system is armed. Make sure you activate your alarm system each time you leave your home, even if you will be gone a short time. It's easy to forget to arm your system when you leave in the morning and not want to drive back when you remember. It could definitely be worth the extra few minutes to protect your home and belongings. There are now alarms that will allow you to arm & disarm your system from your cell phone so you never have to worry if you forget. If your children leave the house after you do, train them to always activate the system before exiting. You may want to establish a personal code for cleaning crews, babysitters or other people who have access to your home. Make sure that all of your friends or guests know to arm the system if they happen to be the last ones to leave the house. You can receive text messages to verify when they come and go. Arm your system in the "stay mode" when you have come in for the day or go to bed. Your alarm will be the first step to keeping you safe at night. The key is to keep your alarm system on as much as possible.

If you have a family member, neighbor or friend without an alarm system, now is the time to talk to them. You may motivate them to take steps to ensure their personal safety. There is nothing more valuable than the peace of mind that comes with knowing you're doing all you can to keep your family and property safe.
